SECTION 1 – Scope:

- All work will be along the multi-use path along Gumwood Rd from the state line to Redfield St.
 - From the east edge of Gumwood Rd and if possible 4 feet east of the eastern edge of the multi-use path.
 - The township has the understanding that in some areas it will not be possible to go the full 4 feet east of the eastern edge.
- Clear trash, limbs, dirt, and brush
 - Any hanging branches and vines should also be trimmed back or as high as possible to not interfere with walkers or bikers.
- Mow the grass
- Edge along the east and west sides of the multi-use path
- The goal is for the physical path to be cleared of debris and hazards on at least a yearly basis.
- All debris and trash should be hauled to a proper disposal facility.
 - The township doesn't have any facilities for this or allow any dumping on its property.

SECTION 2 – Bid Process:

- The Township will select a vendor through a review of submittals, reference checks, total estimated costs, and/or interviews prior to the selection.
- The Township Board is the only body who may legally commit the Township to the expenditure of funds for a contract resulting from this solicitation. No costs chargeable to the proposed contract may be incurred before receipt of a fully executed contract.
- The Township reserves the right at its sole discretion, to reject any or all proposals, for whatever reason it deems appropriate, without penalty and to not issue a contract as a result of this request.
- The Township also reserves the right at its sole discretion, to waive informalities and/or errors in the bidding process.
- The Township reserves the right to accept any bid deemed to be in the best interest of the township, including bids that are not for the lowest amount.
- Faxed proposals are not acceptable.
- The vendor is responsible for the timely delivery of the proposal.
- Any proposal received after the deadline will not be considered.
- Sealed bids shall be submitted to the Milton Township Clerk at the Milton Township Hall, 32097 Bertrand St., Niles, MI 49120 by 5:00pm, Tuesday October 17, 2023.

IRAN LINKED BUSINESS CERTIFICATION

Definitions

- (a) "Energy sector of Iran" means activities to develop petroleum or natural gas resources or nuclear power in Iran.
- (b) "Investment" means 1 or more of the following:
 - (i) A commitment or contribution of funds or property.
 - (ii) A loan or other extension of credit.
 - (iii) The entry into or renewal of a contract for goods or services.
- (c) "Investment activity" means 1 or more of the following:
 - (i) A person who has an investment of \$20,000,000.00 or more in the energy sector of Iran.
 - (ii) A financial institution that extends \$20,000,000.00 or more in credit to another person, for 45 days or more, if that person will use the credit for investment in the energy sector of Iran.
- (d) "Iran" means any agency or instrumentality of Iran.
- (e) "Iran linked business" means either of the following:
 - (i) A person engaging in investment activities in the energy sector of Iran, including a person that provides oil or liquefied natural gas tankers or products used to construct or maintain pipelines used to transport oil or liquefied natural gas for the energy sector of Iran.
 - (ii) A financial institution that extends credit to another person, if that person will use the credit to engage in investment activities in the energy sector of Iran.
- (f) "Person" means any of the following:
 - (i) An individual, corporation, company, limited liability company, business association, partnership, society, trust, or any other nongovernmental entity, organization, or group.
 - (ii) Any governmental entity or instrumentality of a government, including a multilateral development institution, as defined in section 1701(c)(3) of the international financial institutional act, 22 USC 262r(c)(3).
 - (iii) Any successor, subunit, parent company, or subsidiary of, or company under common ownership or control with, any entity described in subparagraph (i) or (ii).
- (g) "Public entity" means this state or an agency or authority of this state, school district, community college district, intermediate school district, city, village, township, county, public authority, or public airport authority.
