1. Completion of the Zoning Ordinances.
 - a. Section 3.15 Discussion of roundabouts
 - i. Section A. add at the end.....driver approaching the intersection or roundabout.

- b. Section 3.21A1 “Outdoor Storage in Residential District”
 - i. Change as follows: “Any recreational vehicle parked outside shall be located behind the required front setback or positioned/screened as approved by the Zoning Administrator.”
- c. 3.22 A
 - i. Number of domesticated animals housed in a dwelling unit shall comply with the Dog Law Enforcement Ordinance County of Cass, Michigan.
- d. 3.22 D
 - i. Fenced animal holding areas for parcels 2 acres or larger shall be a minimum of fifty (50) feet from any property line and one hundred (100) feet from any neighboring dwelling. For parcels smaller than 2 acres fenced animal holding areas shall be reviewed and approved by the Zoning Administrator. Pasture areas are not considered holding area.
- e. 3.24 # 4 is blank. This should be deleted
