## Annual Report to the Board of Trustees

Township Fiscal Year **2014-2015** (4/1/2014 - 3/31/2015)

Over the past fiscal year, the Planning Commission has diligently worked on revising the current Zoning Ordinance for Milton Township. It is anticipated that a draft of the Zoning Ordinance will be presented for public comment before the end of 2015.

In addition, the Planning Commission has completed the following specific actions:

1. Held one (1) Public Hearing:
  - a. Application for Rezoning of Broderick Way parcel from Agricultural Production to Rural Residential.
2. Submitted one (1) Zoning Text Amendment for recommendation to the Board of Trustees:
  - a. Amended to increase the number of ZBA members from three (3) to five (5).
3. Additions to the Planning Commission:
  - a. Scott Kretchman (July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2016)
4. Training Opportunities utilized:
  - a. Changes to the RTFA GAAMPS for Residential Zoning areas and farm animals (in house)
5. Issues to be addressed in the next year:
  - a. Public Input on draft Zoning Ordinance
  - b. Consideration of accelerating the rezoning of land to align with the current Master Plan
  - c. Maintenance of Rural Character
